



Renewed discussions between the US and China to negotiate tariff rates on seafood products imported from China do not apply to Atlantic cod products imported to the US market. Pacific Cod: Similar to Atlantic cod, expect limited availability and higher prices with raw materials limited from cuts to Alaskan cod fishing. Demand is high due to Lent, which will place additional pressure on pricing and availability as we move into March. Icelandic Cod: Iceland's cod fishery represents the only bright spot for the global cod complex with Icelandic production expected to remain flat in 2019. However, decreases in Norwegian and Alaskan cod production continue to push the market higher. Additionally, unfavorable exchange rates between the US dollar and Icelandic krona are contributing to higher prices.

Gulf Snow Crab Clusters

King Crab: Production from Alaska's fall fishing season has been sold into the marketplace; supplies are low and prices are high. We note increased demand for live red king crab in overseas markets. Russian brown and golden king crab supplies are comparatively plentiful. High prices across the crab complex are making it an increasingly cost prohibitive item to feature outside of traditional end users like retailers and buffet houses.

March Market Trend: Higher ↑

US king crab supply decreased in 2018 for the third consecutive year.

Dungeness Crab: Cluster supplies are light and prices are higher. The 2018/19 season is wrapped up with industry observers calling the season a bust. Frozen production is limited and just starting to make it to the domestic marketplace at higher prices. Contact us for pricing and availability. **March Market Trend: Higher** ↑

Snow Crab: Global snow crab output is forecast to fall to an 8-year-low in 2019. The projection is based on an expected 35-45% decline in production from the Newfoundland snow crab fishery. US and Japanese buyers will compete for available supplies, which will support prices at record high levels. March Market Trend: Higher ↑

Expect strong prices as the industry navigates through the supply shortage with Lent demand in full swing. Uncertainty also circles the industry amid tariff talks between the US and China. March Market Trend: Higher ↑

Fresh: Fishing is well underway but Icelandic supplies continue to be tight because of high demand and small fishing quotas. Prices will remain high from EU market demand. Additionally, unfavorable exchange rates between the US dollar and Icelandic krona are contributing to higher prices.



Haddock: Chinese production has resumed from the Chinese New Year holiday work stoppage. However, raw materials remain limited and the market is strong. Lenten demand will keep the haddock market at elevated levels. Imports from China are subject to US tariffs, which is also contributing to higher prices. There is little sign of relief in the haddock market. We have frozen-at-sea, once frozen, twice frozen and cello wrapped haddock on the inventory.





Coldwater Tails: A major Canadian producer lost two processing plants to fires in February. The fires destroyed lobster tail and meat inventory in an already tight market. New season raw material is at least two months away. Meanwhile, global demand for live lobsters continues to contribute to higher raw material prices. March Market Trend: Higher ↑

Meat: Once robust, lobster meat inventories are now coming into balance with demand. Supplies were further impacted after a major Canadian producer lost two processing plants to fires. Supplies will tighten until at least early May when production from the Prince Edward Island fisheries reaches the market. Similar to tails, global demand for live lobsters and lack of raw material is expected to support prices at current levels or even contribute to higher prices as we move into March and April. 



Chemical Free: The Alaskan catch is reportedly short of expectations and producing smaller fish. Expect 4/6 oz fillets to be tight. Additionally, there is increased demand for H&G pollock in Russia, Asia and the EU, which could support higher prices. As a reminder tariff rates on seafood products imported from China do not apply to Alaskan Pollock products imported to the US market. March Market Trend: Higher ↑

Saithe (Atlantic Pollock): Priced competitively to cod, pangasius, tilapia and pollock. Frozen-at-sea, chemical free, all natural and Marine Stewardship Council Certified, this fish is known as saithe in European markets. Product of Germany. 
